



## Westerville City Schools Summer 2023 High School Course Opportunities

### Summer School Dates:

Registration and payment must be received by 4:30pm, Wednesday, May 31, 2023

First Term: June 5 to June 26 – 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (No class June 19, 2023)

Second Term: June 27 to July 18 – 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (No class July 4, 2023)

Full Term: June 5 to July 18 – 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (No class June 19, and July 4, 2023)

### Instructional Delivery

Classes are held at Westerville Central High School with a teacher in each classroom from **7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.** A student learns, in large part, through the online delivery of content and instruction using the program Apex Learning. Each student has control of his/her pace of learning. Students can work at their own pace both during and outside of the school day. All tests **MUST** be taken in the classroom with a teacher. Teachers are in the classroom as facilitators to provide guidance, clarification, and assistance to students with their individual questions as students are working independently on the online program.

### Attendance

Attendance is expected every day. Pre-arranged absences will be considered by the teacher/building principal on a case-by-case basis. Attendance is required in order to provide direct instruction and further support the student in course completion. We have found a direct correlation between regular attendance and successful course completion.

### Course Selection

Students are permitted to **register for up to 1 credit** during the Summer Academy.

### Types of Courses

- **Credit Recovery Courses:** (WCS In District Students only)
  - These courses are available for current Westerville City School (WCS) students only. Students must have already received a final grade for the course recorded on their PowerSchool historical grades which will be verified prior to enrollment. Students that have received a failing grade or who wish to better their grade can take credit recovery courses. There is no charge for Summer 2023 credit recovery courses.
- **Credit Advancement Courses**
  - These courses are available to both current WCS students and out of district students. Students that have never taken the course will take the course for Credit Advancement and will incur a fee that is detailed below.
    - **Credit Advancement Registration Fees**
      - .50 credit advancement course - \$100 fee in district students/ \$235 out of district students
      - .25 credit advancement course - \$100 fee in district students/ \$235 out of district students
      - 1.0 credit advancement course - \$200 fee in district students/\$470 out of district students

### Payment Options

If mailing check or money order to the summer academy office after your on-line registration, make check payable to: WCS, Summer Academy; **IMPORTANT: Please indicate name of student on check or money order.**

If paying via EZPay (in-district students only) you must have or create an EZPay account using your students 6-digit ID number. Please visit the WCSOH.ORG; At bottom of page under “Resources” click EZPay. Click on Student Fees to pay for Summer School.

**Transportation is provided** to Westerville Central High School. Please be sure to indicate if transportation is needed. Once the bus routes are determined, bus routes will be posted to student PowerSchool account under “Transportation”. Please visit your PowerSchool account to retrieve your bus route. **Only sign up for bus transportation if you intend to use this service.** Transportation is available for current WCS students only.

### **\*\*Ohio’s State Tests (OST)**

End of Courses exams are part of several courses offered in Summer Academy as noted in the list below and are part of Ohio’s Graduation Requirements. If a student is taking one of these courses for credit advancement, they are encouraged to take the corresponding End of Course exam. If a student is taking one of these courses for credit recovery and is in need of an improved test score to meet the graduation requirements, they too are encouraged to take the corresponding exam. The Ohio Department of Education determines the testing dates which are July 6 and 7, 2023, starting at 7:45am. Call 617-797-7750 – press “0” for more information.

**REGISTER ON-LINE:** This is a two-part registration.

### **FOR IN-DISTRICT REGISTRATIONS:**

**Part 1:** Register for class. Open ParentPortal in PowerSchool. Click on "Forms." Complete Summer Academy form.  
Please allow 48 hours for registration to be verified.

**Part 2:** You must pay by mailing a check, coming to the Summer Academy Office, OR Pay via EZPay (in-district students only).

Drop off or mail payment to: Westerville City Schools, Summer Academy; Academic Enrichment Center; 336 S. Otterbein Ave; Westerville, OH 43081. **IMPORTANT:** Please indicate name of student on check or money order.

**Registration closes at 4:30pm on Wednesday, May 31, 2023.** Registration is not complete until full payment is received. No registrations will be accepted after 4:30pm on Wednesday, May 31, 2023. If mailing, envelope must be postmarked 3 days prior (May 26) to the May 31 deadline.

### **REFUND POLICY:**

**All refunds will be subject to a processing fee.**

If a student registers/pays for a summer class; later finds out (s)he passed the class during the school year and does not need to take the summer class, a full refund will be given.

**Cancel 2 or more weeks prior to first day of class – Possible \$20 fee per class.**

**Cancel less than 2 weeks prior to first day of class – Possible \$30 fee per class.**

**Cancel less than 1 week prior to first day of class – Possible \$40 fee per class.**

**After 1<sup>st</sup> class begins -- \$100 fee per 1-credit class // \$50 fee per .5 credit class (Advancement Class)**

**After 1<sup>st</sup> class begins -- \$25 fee per 1-credit class**

**After 1<sup>st</sup> complete week of class -- No Refund.**
